INDICATION:

Palpitations.

RESULTS:

The patient underwent a 30-day event recording. Baseline transmission revealed a normal sinus rhythm. The 1st transmission where the patient was "woozy" revealed a normal sinus rhythm. The 2nd transmission revealed a normal sinus rhythm. The 3rd transmission revealed a sinus tachycardia with frequent PACs. There was also brief run of atrial tachycardia. The 4th transmission revealed a normal sinus rhythm and sinus tachycardia. The 5th transmission revealed a sinus tachycardia. The 6th transmission revealed a sinus rhythm. The 7th transmission revealed a sinus rhythm with PACs. There was also an episode of atrial tachycardia with 2:1 AV block. There was a transmission which revealed atrial fibrillation with a rapid ventricular response which converted to a sinus bradycardia. There was another episode of atrial tachycardia. The 9th transmission revealed a sinus tachycardia. The 10th transmission revealed a sinus tachycardia.

IMPRESSION:

Event recording showing multiple arrhythmias including sinus tachycardia, atrial tachycardia with block, brief atrial fibrillation with a rapid ventricular response, and sinus rhythm. During several episodes of tachycardia the patient did note lightheadedness.
